Connect Music Licensing is a non-exclusive agent that administers licensing in Canada for the owners and exclusive holders of copyright in sound recordings and music videos. Connect Music Licensing offers a licence for the exhibition and duplication of music videos as well as the duplication of sound recordings. Connect Music Licensing is the licensing agent of all the major record companies in Canada and many independent labels, artists and producers. Connect Music Licensing's members own or control the copyright of the vast majority of all musical audio recordings and music videos produced and/or distributed in Canada.

Anyone who duplicates sound recordings or music videos and anyone who exhibits or broadcasts music videos requires a licence from Connect Music Licensing or authorization from the owner or holder of the copyright. The unlicensed duplication of sound recordings or music videos and/or the unlicensed exhibition of music videos is an infringement of copyright and may be subject to legal prosecution.

Connect Music Licensing does not license the duplication of music videos or sound recordings for sale. All Connect Music Licensing Agreements permit lease only. Connect Music Licensing also does not license the marriage of sound recordings with any video images (synchronization). Applications for these uses must be submitted directly to the respective record company.

AGREEMENT SUMMARY: DJ – SINGLE EVENT LICENCE

The following is a brief summary of the provisions contained in a Connect Music Licensing DJ Single Event Agreement and is not meant to replace the Agreement. For complete terms and conditions, the full Agreement must be read. It is suggested that the Agreement be read in full and consultation with independent legal counsel be obtained prior to execution.

Grant of Licence:

A Connect Music Licensing DJ Single Event Agreement allows the licensee to copy Connect Music Licensing members' sound recordings onto one (1) computer hard drive ("Digital Programs") using MPEG-3 or an equivalent form of compression, but not a higher form of compression. The licensee may also make copies of sound recordings on unlimited physical carriers (CD-Rs, Tapes, Mini-Discs - "Programs").

Programs are only to be made by the licensee and solely for the purpose of performance of recorded musical entertainment at various functions. Licensee may also retain a backup copy of the hard drive, provided that the Sound Recordings are not performed in public.

Term:

The term is for a one-time event that lasts up to 24hrs. For events that are longer than one (1) day, additional single event licences are required.

Fees:

The licence fee is \$50.00 (plus GST or HST) per licence.

Details:

The sound recordings are the sole property of the record companies. The Licensee shall not accrue any rights, including any copyright to sound recordings or to copies of sound recordings contained in the Programs.

This licence is non-transferable and only allows licensee to copy sound recordings for licensee's use only. The Programs are not to be used by anyone other than licensee or licensee's employees.

Connect Music Licensing's member record companies have no obligation to provide sound recordings or any other materials to the licensee. Notwithstanding, the licensee shall only make copies of sound recordings from products commercially produced by the record companies and is strictly prohibited from copying sound recordings from any downloadable source such as the Internet.

Connect Music Licensing may be required on occasion to exclude certain sound recordings from licensee's use upon written instructions from its member record companies.

The Licensee shall not edit, modify or otherwise alter sound recordings. The Programs shall not include sound recordings that are not licensed under the Agreement.

A Connect Music Licensing display licence must accompany the licensee at their event for the public performance of all Programs. Failure to produce the display licence to a Connect Music Licensing inspector may result in an automatic audit of all books, tapes and other relevant records.
